the partner university. The board of examiners of the Faculty of Business				
Administration and Economics at Bielefeld University appoints this person				
as examiner.				
The registration for the Master's thesis takes place at the examination				
office of the Faculty of Business Administration and Economics at Bielefeld				
University. The Master's thesis should normally include no more than 60				
pages. The Master's thesis has to be completed within 6 months after the				
issue date (to be documented explicitly). Theses must be submitted in				
electronic form (as a searchable PDF file, including a declaration of				
independent work with a scanned signature) by the deadline in an email to				
the examination office of the Faculty of Business Administration and				
Economics and both reviewers (open distribution list).				
Further rules are spelled out in the Masterprüfungsordnung (fw.).
